Club Assembly

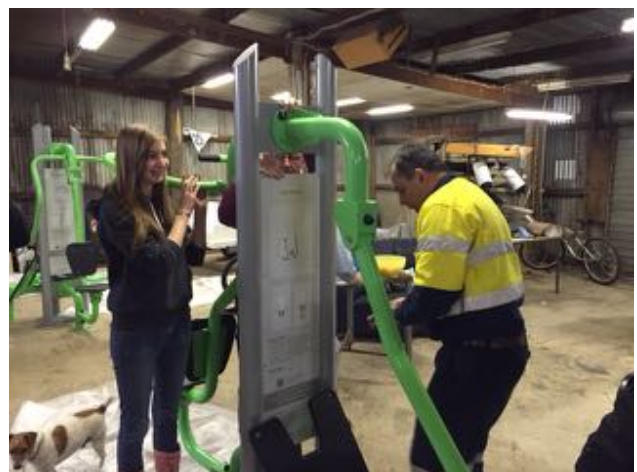
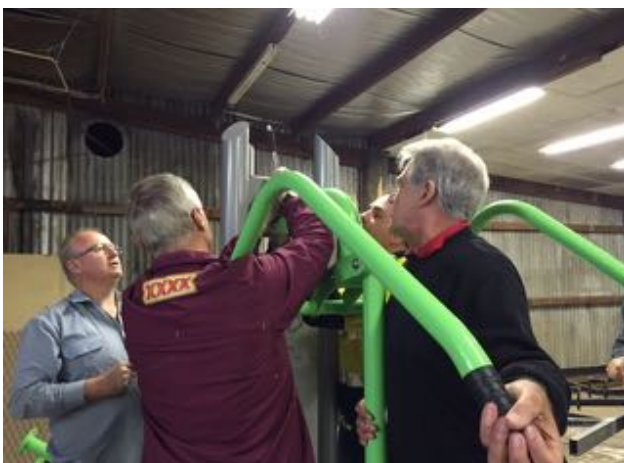
General discussion about the things we currently do and we agreed to continue to do all these events.
