Kim Wiesner recognised Amy Dillon for her work with BWNG.

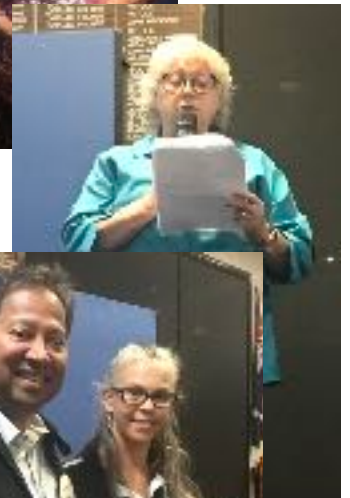
Riko & Josie Fitzgerald recognised their father Ray Fitzgerald for his many efforts within the community.
